- o Treasurer (Heather Miller in Reece's absence)
  - o Balances for all accounts below. From this we have some reserves and commitments that I will present with Budget. Notably, Emergency Prep Reserve, Whole Foods Garden Reserve, Water Fountain Fund (reallocate? We should take into consideration that some of this money came from the school bottle fund that was not part of our fundraiser) and Library/Holly reserved funds unspent, and a prudent budget reserve of \$5000 that we keep to the side each year to ensure the success of our budget regardless of changes in fundraising amounts.
  - Reserves and Commitments are approximately 1/2 of our total funds. We had a successful year last year.
  - **o** Munch 'n Lunch is moving to a built in Visa payment system, eliminating the need for Paypal as they will do direct deposits. This is a much better system, cost is the same.
  - **o** Our Budget for this year will likely be close to \$20,000, allowing around \$7000 for Wishlist, not including Buses for fieldtrips and teacher consumables.

PAC Meeting: Principal's Update – Sept. 14, 2017

Information and things we're proud of since the last PAC meeting... ENROLLMENT, STAFFING and SERVICES:

- 253 students enrolled (last year was 267 at the end of the year)...lost most at the Grade 4 and 6 levels to special programs (MACC, late French Immersion) and a high number of Grade 7s.
- 11 Divisions...see below for details. The organization of classes this year was driven by class composition needs.
- Posting waiting to be filled for the div. 3 grade 5/6 position

- Class size limits: K or classes with K class size limits are 20, Primary classes and 3/4 classes with more Grade 3s have a limit of 22, Grade 3/4 classes with more Grade 4s have a class size limit of 24, and Intermediate classes have a limit of 30.
- We have 28 students with designations, the majority are in the intermediate grades this year. We have 5.5 EAs.
- We have 71 ELL students plus 4 International students. Mrs. Kumar is 0.85 teaching ELL.
- LSS support is 1.05 plus 0.5 Reading Recovery for Grade 1s. Ms. Foy is doing 0.5 Reading Recovery, 0.4 LSS and 0.1 Div. 5 classroom teacher. Other LSS teachers are Mrs. Kimmie, Mrs. Lloyd, Mrs. Kumar, and Mrs. O'Rourke.
- NEW: Ms. Vaughan has been given 0.1 (145 minutes a week) as an Aboriginal Inquiry Learning Teacher. Her role will be to support Aboriginal students and teachers.
- Mrs. Ingham is our counsellor Mondays and Wednesdays, and Winnie Yip is our SLP (speech language pathologist) on Thursdays

• First Week theme was Make a Difference at Montecito...a renewed focus on kindness to others and this newly renovated place. We will be putting together a tree mural in our main hallway. Every child and staff member has made a hand with a commitment of a way they can make a difference at Montecito. We invite PAC members to create a hand as well...see Mrs. Kimmie for details.
