On December 15, you will receive the first report card for your child this school year. This 'learning update' will help you understand how your child has adjusted to their classroom routines and expectations, how your child is doing socially and emotionally, as well as providing proficiency scale levels in academic areas and written comments in some subject areas as well.

Our reports are a collaborative effort blending each child's voice, through self-reflection, with teacher observations. The report provides an opportunity to discuss and celebrate accomplishments, identify challenges as well as assist in creating next steps to support learning for the next term.

As you sit down and look at your child's report with your child, you may want to ask your child the following questions:


- * What did you enjoy learning the most?
