As was shared with you earlier, this school year we will be introducing a change in how we distribute student report cards. Previously they have been handed out to students via a paper copy. Starting this term we will be moving to an online distribution of student report cards via the MyEducationBC Student Portal.


You have already received your child's specific login and password information that will allow you to set-up your child's account via MyEd (check your child's backpack if you haven't seen it!) It is very important that you set up your child's account as soon as possible as student report cards will be published online for your viewing via the MyEd Student Portal on Wednesday, December 18th. All accounts will need to be created prior to being able to view your child's report card.

Attached to this email you have also been provided with the directions that you will need to assist you in setting up your child's student portal account. Once you have set-up your child's student account you will be sent an email each time your child's report card is ready to view throughout the school year and you will be able to print and/or save a copy of this report card at that time for your own records.

We are receiving reports from some families that setting up accounts via your phone is not working. A computer works best. Once accounts are set up, you can view report cards using your phone – just the initial set up of accounts via cell phones is proving problematic.
